

## PRE-PHARMACY (TWO-YEAR TRANSFER PROGRAM)

CODE: S162

The University of Louisiana at Lafayette offers a pre-professional program of study in pharmacy. A student interested in pharmacy should obtain a catalog of the school which he or she plans to eventually attend and use this catalog as a guide for the first two years of course work. Most pre-pharmacy students at UL Lafayette eventually attend either the School of Pharmacy at The University of Louisiana at Monroe or the School of Pharmacy at Xavier University. For those students the following outline of courses is recommended.

<sup>1</sup>Students who plan to attend The University of Louisiana at Monroe must choose electives as follows: ACCT 201; BIOL 261, BIOL 264, HLTH 100, MATH 250, PHYS 208, PHYS 215, PHYS 216, and STAT 214 or 325; eight credit hours from English, Foreign Language, Philosophy, History or Speech; three hours from Art, Music, Dance or Theatre; and three credit hours of a 200 level or higher literature class. Math 270 or 272 may be substituted for Math 109, 110 and 250; however the five hours difference must be taken in electives.

<sup>2</sup>Students who plan to attend Xavier University must select electives as follows: CMCN 200, PHIL 101, either SOCI 100 or PSYC 110; either PHIL 234 or PHIL 235 and a three hour academic elective in any discipline except MATH, SCIENCE, PHYSICAL EDUCATION OR PHARMACY.
